

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OBJECTIVE OF SECURITY

"Reduce the Risk of a Potential Loss to Assets Resulting from Intentional Acts to an Acceptable Level"





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The ASSET most at Risk for any Parking Facility Owner or Operator is DOLLARS!

The Greatest SOURCE of this Risk is CIVIL LIABILITY from NEGLIGENT SECURITY!








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Hierarchy of Your Worst Nightmare:




- Murder or any Fatality
- Sexual Assault
- Assault
- Robbery
- Property Crime
- Committed by Security or Law Enforcement
- Committed by Attendant or any Employee
- Committed by any Other Party





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Security Assessment:




- Identifies Vulnerabilities
- Presents Recommendations to Reduce Risk
- Evidence of "Good Faith Effort" to Exercise DUE CARE.
- May Reduce Insurance Premiums
- Protecting People is simply "The Right Thing to Do" and is good Governance!
- Courts compare against any "Industry Standards"
- Courts compare against "Common Industry Practices" for the Same or Similar Facilities.





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The Opposition to Security is Known as the ADVERSARY





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Security is Defensive in nature.

All Defenses are **Predicated Upon a** Pre-Defined Offense.





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A Security Assessment begins with **ADVERSARY CHARACHTERIZATION:**

- WHO: People most likely to threaten the assets.
- HOW: Tactics & Techniques likely employed.
- WHAT: Tools, Weapons & Materials available.
- WHEN: Time Periods of greatest vulnerability.
- WHERE: Most likely points of attack.
- WHY: Adversary Motivations & Objectives.


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The Design Basis Threat is Determined without Consideration of Existing Security Measures & Vulnerabilities.





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Recognizing Vulnerability Requires an Understanding of the Principles of Effective* Security.

*Perception vs. Reality





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Effective and Comprehensive Security MUST Include the:

- Architectural
- Technological
- Operational

All 3 are Required – None are Effective Independently





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ARCHITECTURAL:

Facility Elements that Affect and Impact Security

- Pedestrian Flow
- Vehicular Traffic Patterns
- Proximity Of Operations
- Structural Issues





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TECHNOLOGICAL:

Elements and Systems that are Purpose-Specific to Security.

- Alarms, CCTV, Access Control
- Vehicle & Pedestrian Barriers
- Emergency Call Stations ("Code Blue")
- Lighting





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OPERATIONAL:

Policies & Procedures Governing the Behavior of All Persons on the Premises.

- Security Patrols
- Personnel Training
- Access Policies & Procedures
- Emergency Response





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THE 6 ELEMENTS OF EFFECTIVE PHYSICAL SECURITY

- DETERENCE
- ASSESSMENT

DELAY

RESPONSE

- DETECTION
- MITIGATION





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DETERRENCE

Creating the Perception that the Probability of a Successful CRIME is Low.

Must be Observable During Adversary Surveillance.

- Formidable Physical Barriers
- Visible Security Technology
- Signage

- Presence of Security Personnel
- Adequate Lighting
- Lack of Concealment





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DELAY

Physical Obstacles to a Rapid Arrival at the Target.

- Formidable Physical Barriers
- Locks
- Distance





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DETECTION

Signaling of a Security Breach to Responsible Personnel.

- Alarm Systems
- "Code Blue" Call
- Direct Observation





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ASSESSMENT

The Validation and Verification of the Nature of a Security Signal.

- Closed Circuit Television (CCTV)
- Direct Observation





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RESPONSE

Action Initiated as a Result of a Validated and Verified Security Signal

- Dispatch Security Personnel
- Notify Law Enforcement





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MITIGATION

Response Activity Intended to Prevent or Minimize the Loss of Assets

- Repel or Apprehend Adversary
- "Lockdown"





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GAP ANALYSIS:


Comparing the 6 Elements Against the EXISTING CounterMeasures.

Applying the Assessor's Knowledge, Skills, Abilities, Training and Experience.





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PROGRAM OF REQUIREMENTS (POR):

The GENERAL Measures and Concepts Determined as Necessary to "Close the Delta" form the PROGRAM OF REQUIREMENTS (POR).





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PLANNING & EXECUTION:

The POR forms the basis for designing, budgeting and implementing the corrective action.





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CPTED:

Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design


Proper Physical Design to Create a Safer Environment and Improve the Quality of Life.





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Retro-Fitting with IP Technology







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The DOWNSIDE of "Self-Assessment":

- Absolutely NO CHANCE of Transferring ANY Liability*
- May result in INCREASED Liability by supporting the "reasonably should have known" argument.
- Unlikely to qualify for "Expert Witness" Status in Legal Proceedings.
- Nearly NO CREDIBILITY with Jurors when Assessor is also the Primary Defendant.
- * Liability does not automatically transfer to the security consultant.





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COMMISSIONING A SECURITY ASSESSMENT:

RULE #1

The Owner's LEGAL COUNSEL Should be the One to Engage the Security Professional for the Assessment.

This is also ALL of the remaining rules!





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COMMISSIONING A SECURITY ASSESSMENT:

BY OWNERS:

To Reduce Risk and Protect Assets

BY CONTRACT OPERATORS:

To Give Owner's "Prior Notice" of Potential Vulnerabilities in Effort to Transfer Risk.
